Whenuapai Athletics Sports Year 7 & 8 2019

Whenuapai School held its annual Year 7 & 8 athletics day on Thursday 31st of October 2019. The sun came out making for ideal conditions. The day started with the 1500 metres with some students testing themselves over this long-distance event. Once completed the students moved through the field events including shot put, high jump, long jump and discus and the track events which included 100m, 200m, 400m and 800m. Some students attempted a new event for the first time and were successful in accomplishing new personal bests.

The competition for the top student in each age category was fierce and every student was attempting to improve across the day. It was evident from the final results that some students performed well in field events like throwing and jumping while other students had greater success in the running track events. Some students preferred the sprints while others enjoyed the longer distance. The day finished with relays with Room 3 being the fastest class overall. The event was made more successful with the support of teachers coordinating their events, recording, timing and general organisation. 




