Inquiry/Creativity focus: NZ HISTORY - do a little bit each day.

Living Through History - We are living through a global pandemic and future students might look back on this moment and ask: how did they feel? How did they make it through? Try to do 3 seesaw posts each week by Friday 3pm:

Maths Post

- Take a photo of your maths work.
- Use the mic tool to explain what you have done.

Writing Post

- Take a photo of your writing.
- Use the mic tool to read a sentence of your writing.
- State what type of sentence you have used.

Choice Post

- Take a photo or video of your work.
- Use the mic or caption tool to explain what you have done.
